Benign para-adrenal bronchogenic cyst (UIC-2)

Breast:

Kidney/Urinary tract/Prostate/Testes/adnexa:

Angiomyolipoma with epithelial cysts (AMLEC) or cystic angiomyolipoma (RU-6)

Post bone marrow transplant TTP (UC-3)

Renal medullary carcinoma (LU-3)

Liver/gallbladder/bile ducts:

Hepatic allograft failure due to bile cast syndrome secondary to hepatic artery thrombosis (RU-3)

Hepatobiliary mucinous cystadenoma (UC-1)

Gallbladder sulfatide polyposis c/w metachromatic leukodystrophy (UC-2)

Systemic hereditary amyloidosis derived from transthyretin-ATTR(Ala60) (LU-6)

Lung:

Biphasic pulmonary blastoma (RU-2)

Usual interstitial pneumonia and a background of nonspecific interstitial pneumonia associated with systemic sclerosis (UC-5)

Congenital cystic adenomatoid malformation (UIC-4)

Lymph node, spleen, bone marrow, blood, etc. (Hematopathology):

Myeloid sarcoma, small bowel (RU-1)
